Therefore we have designed a new range of packaging envelopes & boxes to suit your needs and handle your shipment with utmost care. We make a wide variety of packing solutions available, from heavy materials to fragile items such as mobiles and laptop boxes etc.

Do's

- Please use appropriate size boxes as per weight of the consignment.
- Only use rigid cartons in good condition.
- Place the consignor / consignee address in the label provided on the box

Dont's

- Do not exceed the weight specification of the packaging box(es) used.
- Do not cover or overwrite on the sender / recipient information.
- Do not tape or wrap the labels.

The consignments should not contain any such items or materials which are prohibited or contraband by the law of the land. In the event of any consignment containing any of the aforesaid items or material, the Customer agrees and undertakes to indemnify the Company in respect of all claims and losses that occur in respect of such consignments. Further the customer will be solely responsible for any cost and consequences for booking and couriering such item or material through the Company.

What are Joy of Speed's terms of carriage of shipment?

Joy of Speed advises the parties to insure the goods handed over to Joy of Speed for transportation. Under the consignor insurance in the event of any loss Joy of Speed shall provide COF (Certificate of Facts) on request. A COF charge of 0.2% on the invoice value shall be charged. If the consignment is not insured by the consignor DTDC has provisions to cover under Risk coverage policy, if consignor agrees to pay Risk surcharge as applicable at the time of booking. The maximum value goods carried under Risk coverage by DTDC is Rs. 5,000/-

Fuel Surcharge

Due to recent exorbitant hike in fuel charges, freight charges by various Airlines, Fuel surcharge by major co-loader, Airport handling charges by Airport Authority and Freight charges by Railways, our operation cost has increased significantly and these have left us with no choice but to increase our Fuel surcharge to 50% with effect from 1st November 2016.
